2. The complainant in complaint stated that he applied for new electricity meter vide request no. 8005787123, 8005775993, 8005775987 in the name of Sanjeev Gupta at house no. E-59, TF, UGF & FF Jawahar Park, Laxmi Nagar, Delhi-110092. He also submits that respondent rejected his applications for new connection on the pretext of pending enforcement and energy dues. Therefore, complainant's application for new connection may be granted.
3. OP in its reply briefly submitted that complainant is seeking new electricity connections at premises bearing no. E-59, Jawahar Park, Laxmi Nagar, Delhi-92 for third floor, first floor and under ground floor respectively. The complainant applied for new connection vide request no. 8005787123, 8005775993 and 8005775987.
During site visit on account of multiple deficiencies including outstanding dues the new connections to the complainant were rejected.
4. During the course of hearing both the parties stated that matter is amicably settled between them and they also filed withdrawal letter to this fact.
5. In the facts and circumstances the withdrawal is allowed. Hence, complaint is dismissed as withdrawn.
6. No order as to the cost. Both the parties should be informed accordingly. File be consigned to Record Room.
